ORDINANCE NO. 2015-003

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VINCENT, ALABAMA TO EXEMPT CERTAIN "COVERED ITEMS" FROM THE MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX BEGINS AT 12:01 A.M. ON THE FRIDAY OF THE LAST FULL WEEKEND IN FEBRUARY AND ENDS AT TWELVE MIDNIGHT THE FOLLOWING SUNDAY AUTHORIZED BY ACT 2012-256, GENERALLY REFERRED TO AS THE SEVERE WEATHER PREPAREDNESS SALES TAX HOLIDAY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF VINCENT, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In conformity with the provisions Act 2012-256 enacted by the Alabama Legislature providing for a State Sales Tax Holiday for Severe Weather Preparedness, the City of Vincent, Alabama, exempts "covered items" from municipal sales and use tax during the same period.

- **Section 2.** This ordinance shall be subject to all terms, conditions, definitions, time periods, and rules as provided by Act 2012-256.
- **Section 3.** The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to certify a copy of this ordinance under the seal of the City of Vincent, Alabama, and to forward said certified copy to the Alabama Department of Revenue to be recorded and posted on the Department website.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective on October 6th, 2015, and shall remain in effect until such further date as the council deems the sales tax holiday for Severe Weather Preparedness to not be in the best interest of the City of Vincent.
