ORDINANCE 90-001

SPEED LIMITS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VINCENT, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: An ordinance fixing and establishing the speed limit for Raley Street for the purpose of preserving public peace, order, and welfare within the municipality of Vincent, Alabama.

SECTION 2: Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Vincent Alabama that the speed limit for Raley Street, located between state highway #231 south of town and county highway #62 east of town, be fixed and set at 25 miles per hour with a sign posted at each end of the street.

SECTION 3: Should any person be found in violation of this ordinance hedsahll be written a ticketaby the Townsof VincentiPolice Department and be required to appear befor the Judge in Vincent Municipal Court to answer to the charge of speeding.

SECTION 4: This ordinance is enacted in good faith for the public interest, and shall become effective immediately with the ordinance passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
