

SPEED LIMITS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VINCENT, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: An ordinance fixing and establishing the speed limits for College and Darnell streets for the purpose of preserving public peace, order, and welfare within the municipality of Vincent, Alabama.

SECTION 2: Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Vincent, Alabama that the speed limit for College and Darnell streets, located between #231 and #85 on the east of town, be fixed and set at 25 miles per hour, with a sign posted at three locations. Two entrances to the street from #231 and one entrance on #85.

SECTION 3: Should any person be in violation of this ordinance he shall be written a traffic ticket by the Town of Vincent Police Department and be required to appear before the Judge in the Vincent Municipal Court to answer to the charge of speeding.

SECTION 4: This ordinance is enacted in good faith for the public interest, and shall become effective immediately with the ordinance passage, approval and publication as provided bylaw.
