ORDINANCE 93-002 ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES UPON THE PREMISES OF VINCENT MUNICIPAL PARK

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF VINCENT, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful, for any person to drink, or have in the open or unconcealed possession, or custody for drinking, selling, serving, dispensing or to give away, or attempting to drink, sell, serve or give away, any alcoholic beverage hereafter, while upon any street, avenue or alley or in any public building or upon any public property or while in any other public place in the Town of Vincent, Alabama. As used in this section, this term "public place" shall mean and include any place or gathering which the public generally attends or is admitted to either by invitation, common consent or right, or by payment of admission or other charge, and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, shall include any park or other place of amusement, and any athletic contest; provided that such term shall not mean or include premises that have been duly licensed by the city for sale thereon of such alcoholic beverages.

 $\underline{\tt SECTION~2.}$ That any previous ordinance or parts of ordinances which conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. It shall be the duty of the Town of Vincent Police Department and its officers, and any other person so named by the Town Council to arrest and detain any person or persons considered by them to be in violation of this ordinance. The person or persons shall be ticketed and notified of their day in court in the municipality of the Town of Vincent.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is enacted in good faith for the public interest, and shall become effective immediately with the ordinance passage, approval and publication as provided by law. The City Clerk is hereby directed to have this ordinance published by posting said ordinance in three public places within the city limits of the Town of Vincent, such places being the Town Hall, the Utilities Office and the United State Post Office, for a period of five days as required by state law.
